 Exhibit 1: Educational Purpose

School trips are not vacations. Student travel sponsored by Nebo School District is intended to provide students with meaningful educational experiences they could not otherwise have.

Under Nebo School District Policy IICA, *Student Educational Travel*, an average of four (4) hours per day, including weekends and other non-school days, must be of an educational nature or consist of events directly related to the educational purpose of the trip.

The following table outlines examples of activities that may or may not count toward the educational nature or purpose of the trip.

¹ Practice for a performance or competition may count for up to 10% of the total required educational portion of a trip. While teams may practice more than that, no more than 10% of the total time allocated to an educational purpose may consist of practicing.
